Connecting styles such as contemporary dance, physical theatre and hip hop with Flamenco, circus and puppetry, NEX•US features work by leading and emerging dancers. Devised for this season, Phunktional presents acclaimed Flamenco dancer Tomas Arroquero in Pasodoble and Circus Oz's Rockie Stone in Facet. These duets collapse boundaries between disciplines and explore the multifaceted relationships that spring from collaboration.

Tony Yap Company, Australia's leading culturally diverse movement ensemble, presents Lumière while Melbourne-born Indigenous artist Jacob Boehme presents an excerpt from his work-in-progress, Lu'arn, based on a traditional Boonwurrung story as told by Aunty Carolyn Briggs. From Queensland comes a short work by students of the Aboriginal Centre for the Performing Arts. Guest performers include Carlee Mellow presenting an excerpt from Prologue, blending music, choreography and improvisation.

This new body of work, Veiled In Plain Sight, has been made specifically for Midsumma and the relaunch of Tacit Contemporary Art in Abbotsford.

Connecting to his past aesthetic, Veiled In Plain Sight reaches deeper beneath the skin of the artist. In its directness and sometimes confronting physical truth, the concept of self remains hidden, veiled in plain sight. Continuing to explore ideas from earlier work, Bateson's own history of marks and tone enter his imagery, providing a link between the temporal self, the sexual and the creative. Through the media of photography, painting and drawing, he confronts his own strength and weakness, sadness, tenderness, desire and acceptance.

Bateson first explored the concept of self and his own sexuality 10 years ago at the launch of Tacit Contemporary Art in Thornbury. This new exhibition celebrates both the continued exploration of identity by the artist and the rebirth of Tacit in its new location.

Vivien St James 1965 - 2009 is an exhibition providing a rare opportunity to catch a glimpse of the unique costume collection of one of Melbourne's most iconic and respected performers. Through costume, we see the evolution of a personality and profession spanning a 20 year period of contemporary queer culture. One woman's personal journey of transformation is realised: a state of perfection through her attention to detail and unique sense of style. Throughout her career, Vivien was focused on the continual construction and development of her identity: this evolution of self is evident in her vast collection of clothing, jewellery and costume. Knowing that appearances are everything, Vivien worked closely with many creative people to construct her glamorous, larger than life identity. This exhibition features a selection of her vast personal costume collection, showcasing the work of some of Melbourne's top clothing and costume designers, artists and photographers, illustrating how they contributed in the building of Vivien's public persona.

In turns joyful, disturbing and deliberately ambiguous, these artworks expose the theatricality involved in our everyday performance of gender roles.
